

DPPA: THE DEVELOPMENT

DPPA Decree (No. 80/2024/ND-CP issued date July 03, 2024) has now resolved many of the challenges:

- > Meets Corporate need for RE through financial contracts.
- > Provides mechanism for private sector-led RE investment.
- Supporting EVN to recover transmission & distribution costs and contribute to ensuring grid reliability.

DPPA: Decree 80 Governing Scope



Applicable to:



Renewable Energy GENCOs
 Virtual DPPA: Limited to 10MW+ wind & solar



 Large electricity consumers (monthly avg of 200,000 kWh or higher)
 Virtual DPPA: Limited to Manufacturing consumers connected at 22 kV+



 Virtual DPPA only: Electricity Retailers in zones, clusters (including Industrial Parks), authorized by Large Manufacturing consumers ("Authorized Retailer")



- 4. Power units, including:
 - National System & Market Operator (NSMO)
 - Power Transmission units
 - Power Corporations under EVN & other retailers
 - EVN

RE GENCOs and large electricity consumers must comply with laws and regulations on: a) planning and investment (including National PDP and provincial plans); b) electricity operation licenses; c) safety, fire and explosion prevention and control in construction; d) power purchase and sale contracts; and e) other relevant laws.
