


Key deliverables of the 8th Summit of Leaders






The GMS ISD aims to establish the GMS as a dynamic hub of **innovation**, **creativity**, and **sustainable development**, driving inclusive economic prosperity, and improving the well-being of its people through a more sustainable and integrated economy.



This document outlines (i) the work and accomplishments of the GMS Program Since the Last Summit, (ii)the various **Deliverables** for the 8th GMS Summit; and (ii)the proposed **Future Directions** for the GMS Program.



The DAP proposes a list of actions in three key sectors of the GMS Program: Agriculture, Tourism and Trade and investment.



The RIF 2027 comprises 176 projects with a total estimated investment of \$26.4 billion



The GSIP operationalizes the GMS Gender Strategy with specific activities and outputs.







Key messages by GMS Leaders





Enhanced Multilateral Cooperation for Resilience

Leaders emphasized unity to tackle challenges like and strengthening coordination with other regional initiatives, enhancing collaboration with international organizations, and mobilizing diverse stakeholders to achieve common goals.



Improved Connectivity

Strengthening infrastructure and digital integration was prioritized to boost trade investment and seamless regional cooperation.





Focus on Innovation

Digital transformation and innovation were highlighted as drivers of competitiveness and growth, with the GMS Innovation Strategy and the Digitalization Action Plan



Sustainability and Inclusivity

Commitments were made to promote green growth, climate action, gender equality and equitable development for a sustainable future








8th GMS Summit: Energy-related Joint Declaration





- 5. To address the pressing challenges of climate change and energy security, the GMS Energy Transition Task Force was established in 2022 to accelerate the **transition to cleaner energy sources and energy efficiency** in the subregion.
- 10. **Strengthening links with other RCI initiatives** is a key element of this transformation. This includes the GMS energy program's enhanced cooperation with the related initiatives of the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN).
- 16. In **energy**, the GMS energy program enhanced its cooperation with development partners and ASEAN and has actively engaged in discussions on the ASEAN Power Grid, aimed at deeper coordination on multilateral and regional power trade. The GMS Energy Transition Task Force is implementing a **two-year work plan** focused on energy efficiency and demand-side management. The forthcoming **GMS Energy Sector Strategy 2024–2030** will define the strategic priorities of the GMS energy cooperation program toward a secure and green energy future for the region.



8th GMS Summit GMS Leaders' speech: Reference to energy



PRC

 will actively promote the planning, construction and upgrading of regional power grids, deepen cooperation in the new energy battery, automobile and photovoltaic industries, expand cooperation in emerging fields such as clean energy, intelligent manufacturing, big data, and smart cities, and cultivate and expand new momentum for regional development.

LAO PDR

• acknowledged GMS 2030's emphasis on utilizing environmentally friendly clean energy in industrial and agricultural production and supporting clean energy transition.

VIETNAM

 noted China's large energy corporations expressing plans to expand investment in Viet Nam particularly in in renewable energy, hydrogen, energy storage, upgrading the electricity grid, improving technical processes at power plants, and enhancing energy efficiency.
