- ➢ Grid Code − December 2018
  - Gap Assessment of Performance Standards; and Roadmap for Compliance
  - Compliance Assessment of the GMS Grid Code with National Codes; and Road Map for Compliance
  - Identification of solutions for regulatory enforcement of the GMS Grid Code
  - Grid Code review
- Regional Master Plan June 2019
  - Review, validate and updating
  - Establish Strategic Planning Criteria
- Feasibility Studies of priority projects: July 2018 June 2020

#### Group Composition

- (i) Transmission System Planning and Operation Expert:
  One designated staff of the National Transmission System
  Operators (TSO) or National Power Authorities having
  experience in transmission system planning and operation; +
  one more expert as alternate
- (ii) +Grid Code Specialist: One designated staff from the TSO
- (iii) Power Generation Planning and Operation Expert: One designated staff of National Power Authorities having experience in generation planning and operation;
- (iv) Expert Having Regulatory Experience: One designated Ministry Official or National Regulators with primary responsibility for regulatory aspects of the energy sector.
