 - Re-orienting the PHC to achieve UHC _ training of basic health staffs at grass root level, MCH, China-ASEAN MCH cooperation center, Digital health for remote facilities including standardizing of information, knowledge programme
 - Traditional medicine_ Joint research, capacity building programme
- What are the barriers to achieving them?
 - Funding issues, leveraging domestic resource and DP's resources
 - Improving awareness and engaging other sectors
 - Setting up mechanism for overseeing implementation
- What concerns do you have about either the priorities or the strategy development process?
 - M&E to be done by third party, narrow down indicators for country level for reporting
 - Resources to international cooperation allow only for China, no ear-mark fund to support activities in overseas. (China can host regional training inside China in collaboration with other countries)
