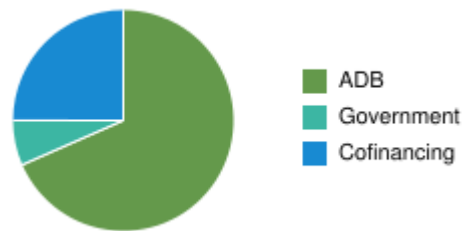

Myanmar attracts tourists because of its friendly people, rich culture and competitive prices. In 2012 the country hosted around one million foreign visitors. If Myanmar maintains political stability and high levels of growth, international visitor arrivals are forecast to rise as high as 5.14 million in 2020, with corresponding tourism receipts worth \$6.9 billion.
